The storage facilities meet the legislated storage requirements for handguns detailed hereunder;

**Longarm licences for category C or D longarms and handgun licences**

- (1) The firearm must be stored in a steel safe—
  - (a) which is of a thickness that is not easily penetrable; and
  - (b) which, if it weighs less than 150 kilograms when it is empty, must be bolted to the structure of the premises where the firearm is authorised to be kept; and
  - (c) which, when any firearm is stored in it, is locked.
- (2) If more than 15 firearms are stored on the premises where the firearm is stored, the premises must be fitted with an effective alarm system.
- (3) Any ammunition for the firearm must be stored in a locked container separate from the safe in which the firearm must be stored.

**MINIMUM RECOMMENDED SPECIFICATIONS FOR A SAFE**

- (i) Not less than 4.75mm (3/16") mild steel plate (thinner plate if hardened steel should be satisfactory), welded construction, suitably reinforced.
- (ii) The security of the safe shall not depend on external hinges or lock.
